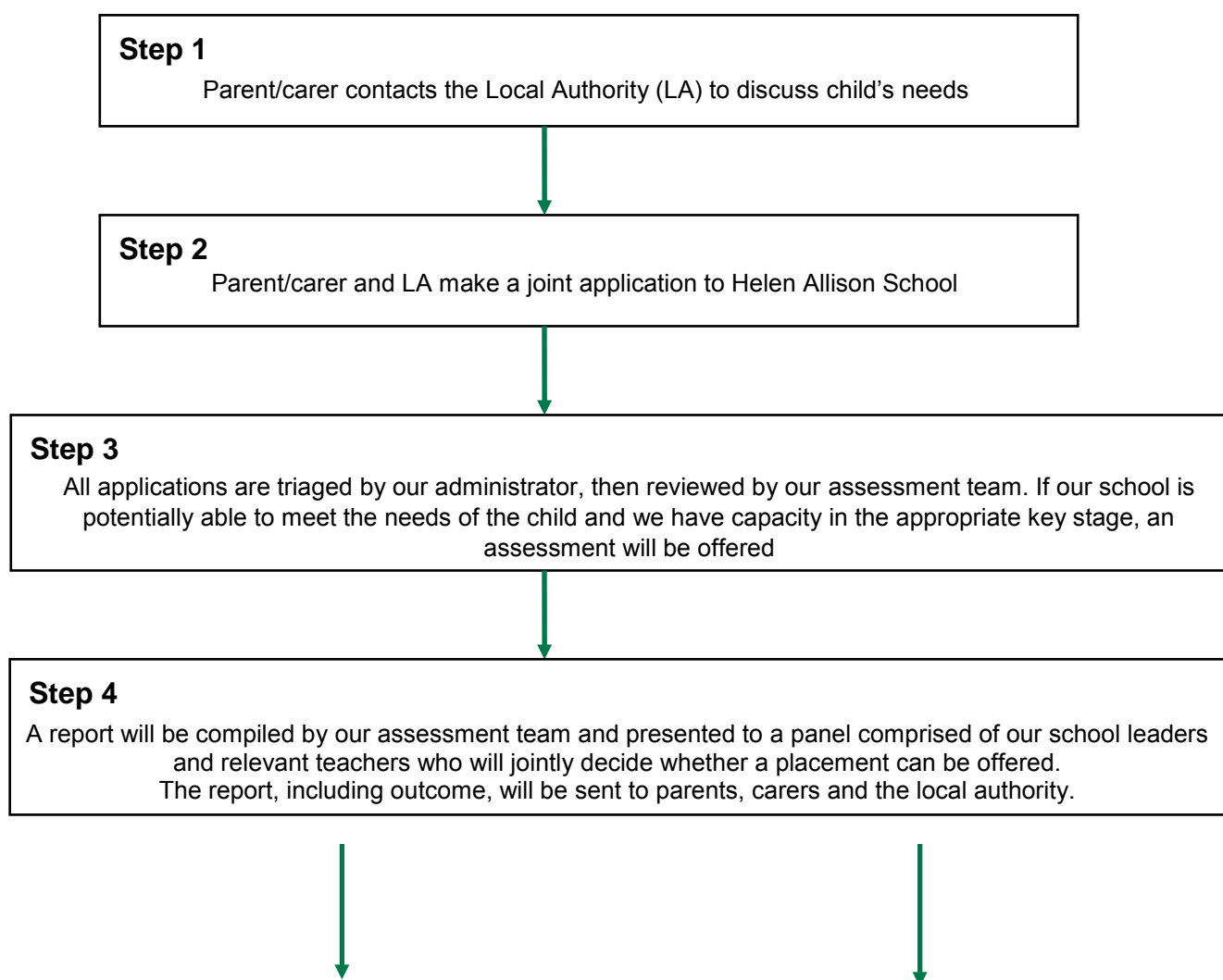

Our school can consider referrals for children and young people who have a diagnosis of autism and an EHCP in place. The Helen Allison School admission criteria includes: a compatible peer group; appropriate learning environment; and for pupils to be able to access the Helen Allison School curriculum offer.

The Helen Allison admissions flowchart below is a step-by-step guide to the referrals and admission process. We hope you find this guide useful.

**Step 5**

A proposal will be sent to the LA.

**Step 6**

The contract needs to be agreed by both parties: our school and the Local  
Authority.

**Step 7**

We host an admissions meeting, inviting parents/carers to meet with us again to gather  
more information and agree a transition plan.

**Step 8**

We will send parent/carer an admissions pack, which includes information for  
parents, carers and the child

**Step 9**

The child starts school.
