Located on a private estate near Rushden and it's beautiful lakes.

We provide person centred support to encourage people to be as independent as possible.

Care categories

Autism and associated learning disabilities.

Staffing ratio and provided care

We are able to provide support to meet the individual needs of the people who live within the service. Support is on a 1:1 basis or unsupported time for independence where appropriate. There is currently a sleep-in member of staff.

Our staff undertake a comprehensive autism induction including positive behaviour support and communication and provide a low arousal

We are able to provide support to maintain healthy lifestyles, medication and personal care, as well as developing health action plans and participating in activities in the community and work placement.



Service facilities

Melloway is a modern three bedroom house which is currently being refurbished throughout. There is a communal lounge and rear garden with a garage for storage.

Although the vacant bedroom has no en-suite there is a communal bathroom and a downstairs toilet.

Community facilities

Across the road from Melloway we are able to benefit from a large park enjoyed by us and the local community including dog walkers and children.

There are a range of community facilities within walking distance including a gym with swimming pool and a local church. Within a short bus journey other local activities include a gaming workshop, a shopping centre and even a wrestling class.

Placement suitability

Admission criteria:

- have appropriate funding
- be over 18 years of age
- have a diagnosis of autism

Currently residing in the service are two reserved gentlemen therefore this vacancy would suit a gentleman who respects personal space and interacts with peers on a needs basis.

The two gentlemen who reside at Melloway are independent and there is a designated smoking area for one. Although they interact they prefer their own space. This is a quiet house however it can at times become loud.
