We currently have one room available in this 6 bedroom detached residential house in Gravesend, Kent.

Overcliffe

Located in a lovely residential area, just a couple minutes walk from Gravesend station and nearby local amenities, waterfront, parks and leisure centres.

The residential service consists of two spacious houses, each bedroom personalised to suit individual style and needs.

Care categories:

Autism spectrum disorders and associated learning disabilities.

Staffing ratio and provided care

We provide 24 hour support and a staff member ratio of 1:2, 1:1 and 2:1 or 3:1 for certain activities.

Our staff who are trained to understand autism are able to provide a supportive and encouraging environment so that each individual can achieve their goals. Our guidance, advice, information, and practical support are there to help them work towards an independent life.

2 houses (6 adults in each house)

Staff are there to provide effective support around different aspects of living with others and life skill development to ensure they are happy, safe and secure in their own home.

We provide support to maintain healthy lifestyles, medication and personal care, as well as developing health action plans and participating in sporting and recreation activities.



Service facilities:

The houses have a large secluded and peaceful communal back garden where we regularly do BBQs as well as a green house and vegetable patch.

A large kitchen where everyone shares their evening meal but we also have a quiet room for those who would prefer some time alone.

The service has two minibuses which are shared with all people in the house for day trips to our nearby activity Centres.

Community facilities:

The service is in close proximity to shops, parks, cinemas and restaurants as well a short drive to the seaside.

There is also an excellent train Service with London less than 30 minutes away.

People living here are able to enjoy fun and social leisure activities, holidays, cultural and religious interests.
